Applying for State Licensure Through Reciprocity

[Reference: Section 73-6-13(4)]

- Will be at the Board's option on an individual basis by a majority vote of the Board of Chiropractic Examiners.
- Must be an adult of good moral character.
- Must be a currently active, competent practitioner for at least eight years.
- Must hold an active chiropractic license in another state, with no disciplinary action or unresolved complaint pending anywhere.
- Must demonstrate having obtained licensure as a chiropractor in another state under the same education requirements which were equivalent to the educational requirements in this state to obtain a chiropractor license at the time the applicant obtained the license in the other state.
- Must satisfactorily pass the examination administered by the Board of Chiropractic Examiners.
- Must meet the requirements of Section 73-6-1(3), having completed a course of study containing a minimum of one-hundred twenty (120) hours of instruction in the application of therapeutic modalities.
