

MISSISSIPPI STATE BOARD OF CHIROPRACTIC EXAMINERS
MINUTES OF April 27, 2017

The Board of Chiropractic Examiners met at the Residence Inn, Ridgeland, MS. The meeting was called to order at 8:29 a.m. by Dr. Pernell.

Vice Chairperson Pernell declared a quorum at 8:31 a.m.

Dr. Allen motioned for the acceptance of the minutes for the January 26, 2017 board meeting. Dr. Norville seconded. Motion passed unanimously.

Dr. Allen motioned to accept the following Treasurer's report:

Dr. Norville seconded. Motioned passed unanimously.

There was no Continuing Education committee report.

There was no Rules and Regulations committee report.

Dr. Ritch motioned to allow the following graduate chiropractors to sit the Jurisprudence examination: Mathew Alan Ortman, D.C., Annalea K. Wood, D.C. and Stephen R. Stone, D.C. They have met all requirements. Dr. Norville seconded. Motion passed unanimously.

There was no legislative report.

Dr. Allen motioned to accept all committee reports. Dr. Norville seconded. Motion passed unanimously.

On motion by Dr. Ritch, seconded by Dr. Allen, the Board unanimously voted to go into a closed determination session to consider whether it needs to go into Executive Session.

In the closed meeting, Dr. Allen motioned, with a second by Dr. Ritch, that the board had a reason to go into Executive Session, namely Strategy session or negotiations with respect to prospective litigation or issuance of an appealable order. Within the Executive Session, the Board took the following action: 1. Concerning complaint 31-05 this complaint is still active in the Supreme Court. 2. Concerning complaint 31-09B this complaint is still active. A letter is to be sent to the Doctor concerning the lack of observer in his office. 3. Concerning the complaint 31-40 Dr. Pernell IO this is not a Board issue. Dr. Allen motioned to remand the complaint to the files. Dr. Norville seconded. Motion passed unanimously. 4. Concerning the complaint 31-41 Dr. Pernell IO after discussion of the facts and on advice of counsel, Dr. Allen motioned to have a July hearing on the matter. Dr. Norville seconded. Motion passed unanimously. 5. Concerning complaint 31-36 Dr. Allen motioned to send the matter to the Physical Therapy Board. Dr. Ritch seconded. Motion passed unanimously. 6. Concerning complaint 31-37 Dr. Allen IO motioned for this matter to be forwarded to the Tennessee Chiropractic Board. Dr. Norville seconded. Motion passed unanimously. 7. Concerning complaint 31-38 Dr. Ritch IO. This complaint is not considered a Board issue. Dr. Allen motioned. Dr. Norville seconded. Motion passed unanimously. 8. Concerning complaint 31-39 Dr. Pernell IO upon careful consideration of the fact Dr. Allen motioned to table this complaint until the July Board Meeting. Dr. Ritch seconded. Motion passed unanimously. Upon conclusion of the business for Executive session, the Board voted, upon motion made by Dr. Ritch and seconded by Dr. Pernell to come out of Executive session. Having exited the Executive Session, the Board resumed in open meeting by announcing the above described action.

Dr. Ritch motioned to issue licenses to the following graduate chiropractors: Mathew Alan Ortman, D.C., Annalea K.Wood, D.C. and Stephen R. Stone, D.C. Dr. Norville seconded. Motion passed unanimously.

Dr. Allen motioned to approve pay vouchers. Dr. Ritch seconded. Motion passed unanimously.

There being no further business, Dr. Norville motioned for adjournment. Dr. Allen seconded. Motion passed unanimously.
