The Board of Chiropractic Examiners held a called special meeting by phone on July 15 2022. The meeting was called to order at 12:15 p.m. by Chairman Dr. Allen.

Chairman Allen declared a quorum at 12:17 p.m.

On motion by Dr. Henderson, seconded by Dr. Armstrong the Board unanimously voted to go into a closed determination session to consider whether it needs to go into Executive Session. In the closed meeting, Dr. Armstrong motioned, with a second by Dr. Patterson, that the board had a reason to go into Executive Session, namely a strategy session or negotiations with respect to prospective litigation or issuance of an appealable order.
